








How to draw a cow

Hi there kids! We have created this simple, step-by-step tutorial on how to draw a cow. The tutorial is as elementary as possible that even young artists with any level of knowledge can enjoy it.




Cows have 32 teeth. A cow will chew about 50 times in a minute, making their jaws move about 40,000 times a day. A cow's milk is one of the best sources of calcium available and Calcium contributes to the development and maintenance of bones and teeth in children.



What you'll need:


- Piece of paper
- Colour Pencils and/or Felt Tip Pens
- Your creative imagination

Set-by-Step Drawing Worksheet




1. Draw the head

Draw a vertical oval on the left side of the sheet of paper. Remember that the top half should be slightly narrower than the bottom.



2. Draw the body


Now draw a horizontal oval that is larger than the one drawn for the head. Notice how the oval from the first step overlaps in this step.



3. Draw the ears, tail and muzzle

The ears are like petals that should line up with the sides of the top of the head. Draw a tail on the right side of the body, it should be curved downward, while the tip of the tail is pointed.

Draw a curved line inside the bottom of the head to create a muzzle. Note that the muzzle is almost a third of the head in size.




4. Draw the paws, horns and the tip of the tail

You can draw the paws with four elongated vertical ovals. The legs should be drawn in pairs: two legs closer to the head and two closer to the tail.

Draw horns between the ears. They are similar to the shape of the ears, only smaller in size and the tip is more pointed, also, unlike ears, the horns are directed upwards.

The tip of the tail is like the tip of a brush.




5. Draw the eyes, nostrils, mouth and hooves

Just below the ears, inside the head, draw two identical small circles – this will be the outline of the eyes. On each circle, draw filled dots – these are the pupils.

At the top of the muzzle, draw two open circles for the nostrils. And below, draw a curved line pointing upward – it's a happy cow!

Now draw the hooves – in the lower part of the paws draw lines on each paired side so that the tips are the same size.



6. Draw the spots and udders

On the body, draw several oval spots of different sizes.

Draw the udder under the body, between the legs.

7. Colour your drawing and remember to have FUN!!
